FIRE ALARM REGULATIONS

If a fire breaks out, it is necessary to take all appropriate measures to localize, extinguish and report the fire quickly. A person who notices a fire on the premises is obliged to extinguish the fire by himself, or with help of others, with a fire extinguisher or by using other suitable means, and to report the fire or ensure reporting of the fire to the fire control centre.

YOU CAN REPORT A FIRE AT THE FIRE CONTROL CENTRE IN THE GATEHOUSE A03, TEL. 541 142 978 OR EXTENSION 2978

You can report a fire: by phone or in person at the fire control centre.

If a fire is reported by phone, the caller shall state his name and the telephone number he is telephoning from, he shall report on the place of fire and what is on fire.

Fire control centre will report the fire to:

Fire alarm is announced by a public-address system.

Head of the Halls of Residence or his representative will take control of antifire and rescue operations until the arrival of the regional fire rescue service units, he will issue instructions and assign tasks in order to extinguish the fire, switch off the electricity, turn off the main seal of media and suchlike. In the absence of the head of the Halls of Residence and his representative, the doorkeeper on duty takes control of evacuation of persons, issues instructions and assigns tasks. Fire wardens perform fire extinguishing operations and help evacuate persons. Employees, students and other persons who are on the premises at the time of the fire are obliged to exit the premises via the nearest fire escape upon the evacuation alert.
