

## **FIRE ALARM REGULATIONS**

If a fire breaks out, it is necessary to push the button of a fire alarm box and take all appropriate measures to localize, extinguish and report the fire quickly. A person who notices a fire on the premises is obliged to extinguish the fire by himself, or with help of others, with a fire extinguisher or by using other suitable means, and to report the fire or ensure reporting of the fire to:

**THE REGIONAL FIRE RESCUE SERVICE CONTROL ROOM, TEL.: 150**

Whereas it is necessary to state:

- a) who is telephoning and the telephone number the person is telephoning from
- b) address and name of the premises hit by the fire
- c) what materials are on fire and to what extent

Fire alarm is announced by shouting “FIRE” (“HOŘÍ – HOŘÍ“) and by a public-address system.

Until the arrival of the security agency or the regional fire rescue service units try to exit the building via the nearest fire escape. Follow the instructions of security agency employees after their arrival. Employees of the security agency perform fire extinguishing operations, evacuation of persons and, where necessary, switch off the electricity and turn off the main seal of media.
